This summer, our Eco-Discovery campers will explore the fascinating journeys that animals and plants make to find everything they need to survive. How far must animals move each day to find food—and how do they move their bodies to get there? How do plants find a way to move to find water and nutrients? From plants that climb high or creep low, to animals that travel from under the water up to the land and sky, the natural world is full of adventure!
